\$4500 stipend for each of two summer programs (2024 and 2025), faculty mentoring, academic programming, no-cost GRE preparation, financial support for expenses related to research and graduate applications, and up to **\$10,000** for undergraduate loan repayment with successful and minimum enrollment in a Ph.D. program.

- Sophomore or junior standing at the time of application (expected graduation date of Spring 2026; graduation dates of Spring 2025 will be considered on a case by case basis with consultation)
- Academic promise with a 3.3 minimum GPA;
- Interest in pursuing graduate education, especially a PhD, in an eligible discipline of the humanities or humanistic social sciences (see below)
- Potential for serving as a mentor and teacher for a wide variety of students;
- Activities and leadership that reflect an interest in social justice issues and the promotion of multivocality;
- Availability for, and commitment to, full and enthusiastic participation in all aspects of the MMUF program, including attendance at conferences and regular meetings;
- Status as a US citizen, permanent resident, as well as Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA) or undocumented status.
