Many are familiar with Brian May as the lead guitarist in the iconic band, Queen. But his "side-gig" in astrophysics is less known. He studied in this field at Imperial College in London before he launched into his music career.

A little over 30 years later, he returned to the classroom to complete his doctoral thesis. He worked with NASA to launch a reconnaissance spacecraft, known as New Horizons, to Pluto in 2015, by contributing to data analysis and stereoscopic imagery. He released a song called New Horizons in 2019 which captures the wonder of distant exploration.

CHRISTMAS TREE SPINACH DIP BREADSTICKS RECIPE

The best part of the holidays is the food! Here is a delicious recipe for the best holiday party appetizer: bread sticks stuffed with spinach and cheese and topped with garlic butter. Feel free to customize as you please; I might put several kinds of cheese and maybe even more seasoning! This recipe takes roughly 30 minutes to prepare. **Enjoy! Happy Holidays!**

INGREDIENTS

- 12 oz chopped spinach
- o 6 oz cream cheese, softened
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- o 1/2 teaspoon salt
- o 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- o 1/4 teaspoon chili powder
- o 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- o 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- o 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- o 1 cup grated cheddar OR mozzarella cheese
- o 1 tube refrigerated thin crust pizza crust
- o 2 tablespoons butter
- o 1/2 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- o 1/2 teaspoon garlic salt

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Preheat oven to 400 degrees.
- 2. In a bowl, beat together the spinach and cream cheese.
- 3. Add garlic, salt, onion powder, chili powder, pepper, and Italian seasoning and beat to combine.
- 4. Add parmesan cheese and 1/2 of the cheddar or mozzarella cheese and beat to combine. (The other half of the cheddar or mozzarella cheese will be sprinkled over the filling when you shape the Christmas tree.)
- 5. Shape into Christmas tree as directed in the post.
- 6. Bake for about 22 minutes until quite golden brown on top and cooked through on the bottom.
- 7. Melt butter and stir in garlic salt and seasoning, then brush over breadsticks.
- 8. Serve warm.
