- 2) Please include a separate cover sheet with:
  - your name
  - your email and telephone contact information for summer and fall 2011
  - the title of the paper
  - the course for which it was written
  - the semester in which the course was taken
- 3) Mark your submission “Erica Ball: American Papers” and turn it in to the American Studies Office, UH-313
- 4) The submission deadline is Friday, June 3, 2011

Authors will receive a letter notifying them of the Editorial Board’s decision at the end of the summer. Accepted essays must be revised and resubmitted in electronic format at the beginning of the fall 2011 semester. Any questions?
