Geography – Spring 2010

As you prepare to register for Spring 2010 courses, you should be aware of the following course changes.

Undergraduate Writing Requirement

GEOG 300A – Geographic Thought will satisfy the Upper-division Writing Requirement. This new course is scheduled for **TuTh 2:30 to 3:45**. Students taking GEOG 300A will no longer need to take ENGL 301 or ENGL 360 to meet this requirement.

What about GEOG 328 ?

GEOG 328 – Global Change and Environmental Systems is a new course that can be used to satisfy the 3 units of Environmental Geography for either the major or the Environmental Analysis Emphasis. During Spring 2010, it can also be used for the Capstone Requirement (see below).
