

MARY LOIS AYRES SCHOLARSHIP IN GERONTOLOGY

These awards, about \$750 (full-time) or \$500 (part-time student) for Fall and Spring Semester, are open to continuing upper division undergraduate students with a concentration or minor in Gerontology and first year graduate students in Gerontology. Criteria include academic achievement, professional promise, and demonstrated interest in a career in the field of aging. The award is intended to defray costs associated with educational activities that are directly related to completion of a degree program.

CRITERIA:

- Undergraduate Minor or Concentration in Gerontology or a first year Master's student in Gerontology
- Enrollment at CSUF in a minimum of 6 units as a junior, senior or Graduate Student
- High Academic Achievement
- Professional promise in Gerontology or the field of aging
- Demonstrated need to defray costs associated with the pursuit of the degree program.

APPLICATIONS: Application materials should include the following information and be submitted to the Coordinator, Gerontology Academic Programs.

1. Name, address, phone number, major, and student ID (use SA Application at: www.fullerton.edu/financialaid/scholar/scholarships_default.htm)
2. A list of courses taken and grades received in Gerontology related courses (provide a copy of transcript).
3. Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which should be from a CSUF faculty member.
4. A goal statement indicating interest in Gerontology and field of aging
