Award Program Description:

This award (approximately \$500) will be offered each June to a MS Gerontology candidate graduating in June or have graduated the preceding Summer or Fall semester at California State University, Fullerton. This award will come from a special account, funded by contributions from OLLI members. No OLLI operating funds will be used.

Judging Criteria:

- * Name, address, phone number, major, and student ID (use SA Application at: www.fullerton.edu/financialaid/scholar/scholarships_default.htm)
- * Grade point average 3.5 or above (provide a copy of transcript)
- * Recommendation of the Scholarship Committee of the Gerontology Programs Council
- * Two reference letters, at least one of which should be from a CSUF faculty member
- * Quality and extent of community service as discussed in essay
- * Membership in either SAGE (Student Association for Gerontology Education) or in Sigma Phi Omega (National Honor Society)
- * A 250 word essay on what graduate plans to do with MS degree in Gerontology
- * Financial need, if applicable

Application: Application materials should be submitted to the Gerontology Academic Program Office, CP-900, by Monday, April 6.
