

KIRT AND DONNA SPRADLIN SCHOLARSHIP IN GERONTOLOGY

These awards, about \$750 (full-time) or \$500 (part-time) student for Fall and Spring Semester, are open to an upper division undergraduate student or a graduate student in Gerontology and a student in the Center for Successful Aging. Criteria include academic achievement, professional promise, and demonstrated interest in a career in the field of aging. The award is intended to defray costs associated with educational activities that are directly related to completion of a degree program. For instance, the funds could be used to defray the cost of books, research materials, or travel to present a paper or participate in a conference on Gerontology.

CRITERIA:

- Upper division undergraduate or admission to the Masters program in Gerontology or Health Sciences/Kinesiology
- Enrollment at CSUF in a minimum of 6 units
- High Academic Achievement
- Professional promise in Gerontology
- Demonstrated need to defray costs associated with the pursuit of the degree program.

APPLICATIONS: Application materials should include the following information and be submitted to the Coordinator, Gerontology Academic Programs.

1. Name, address, phone number, major, and student ID (use SA Application at:
www.fullerton.edu/financialaid/scholar/scholarships_default.htm)
2. A list of courses taken and grades received in Gerontology related courses (provide a copy of transcript).
3. Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which should be from a CSUF faculty member.
4. A goal statement indicating interest in Gerontology and field of aging
