The Center for Retirement Research at Boston College announces the 2012 Sandell Grant Program and 2012 Dissertation Fellowship Program for research on retirement income and disability insurance issues. These programs are funded by the U.S. Social Security Administration.

### 2012 Steven H. Sandell Grant Program

- Provides the opportunity for junior scholars and senior scholars entering a new field to pursue projects on retirement income and disability insurance. The program is open to scholars in all academic disciplines.
- Awards up to seven grants of \$45,000 for one-year projects.
- The submission deadline for grant proposals is Friday, January 27, 2012. Grant award recipients will be announced in March 2012.

### 2012 Dissertation Fellowship Program

- Supports doctoral candidates writing dissertations on retirement income and disability insurance issues. The program is open to scholars in all academic disciplines.
- Awards up to seven fellowships of \$28,000.
- The submission deadline for proposals is Friday, January 27, 2012. Grant award recipients will be announced in March 2012.
