

European Studies Program Study Abroad/Language Program Travel Grants

The European Studies program is pleased to announce student travel grants for up to \$2,000 for study abroad to Europe or for travel to a European language instruction program. Travel must be conducted during spring or summer 2008.

Eligibility: Students from all majors are welcome to apply. Preference will be given to European Studies majors and minors. Language programs may be abroad or in the United States, as long as they provide instruction in a European language. Study abroad programs must be in a European country.

Deadline: December 14, 2007 to the European Studies program office, Humanities 815F.

Students must submit the following:

- a detailed budget of the funds requested. (1 copy)
- a 500 word maximum statement of purpose describing the nature of the travel and how it will benefit your studies. For students studying abroad, describe the specific study abroad program and the location of your studies. For students attending a language instruction, describe the specific language program. (1 copy)
- Provide a copy of the official brochure/catalog from the study abroad program or the language instruction program. (1 copy)
- 1 sealed letter of recommendation from a faculty member. (1 copy)
