## AN INVITATION TO TEACH IN THE HUMANITIES AND SOCIAL SCIENCES STUDY ABROAD PROGRAM

### **SUMMER, 2010 & SPRING, 2011**

The H&SS 2010 Summer and 2011 Spring Study Abroad Program invites faculty applications to teach in one of our four programs: Summer 2010-Florence, **Italy**; Salamanca, **Spain** or Port Elizabeth, **South Africa**; Spring 2011- London, **England**. One teaching opportunity for each location is available. The Selection Committee will review faculty applications and conduct interviews as appropriate making recommendations to the College Dean.

Faculty in the summer program will receive normal summer salary for teaching two courses (6 units). Faculty in the spring program will receive normal spring salary for teaching two courses (6 units).

The selection process schedule for the Study Abroad Program is:

- **Oct. 1, 2009**      Deadline for submission of applications to Dr. Ray Young, in care of the H&SS Dean's Office, H-211.
- **Nov. 10, 2009:**      Acting Dean Della Volpe announces selection of appointee.

The Selection Committee will consider the following in seeking the appropriate appointee:

1. Application form, statement of objectives, and proposed courses (2)
2. Knowledge and speaking ability of the language of that particular country, as appropriate.
3. Support of department chair (and Dean, if faculty member not from H&SS).
4. Personal interview, as appropriate.

3. Describe strategies you would use to assist in recruiting students for the program. (Assistance in recruiting students is expected of the faculty member selected)
4. Describe your experience in working with students outside the classroom and in serving as an advisor and mentor to students.
5. Besides the opportunity of teaching abroad, what other values would a study abroad experience have for you? Please comment on any research plans you may have.
6. Describe any previous experience you have had with this particular city and country, in general.
7. Rate your linguistic ability in Italian or Spanish, as appropriate to your application
8. Attach a curriculum vita.
