The College of Humanities and Social Sciences offers an exciting teaching and learning opportunity for a full-time faculty member to direct CSUF students on a summer experience in the historic center of the arts, Florence, Italy.

Commitment

- Teach 6 units in two general education courses of the faculty member's choosing
- Mentor and support 12- 20 students in course activities and experiential learning
- Serve as liaison to our on-site housing and services provider, A.I.F.S. (American Institute for Foreign Study)

Compensation

- Receive normal summer session salary for 6-unit teaching load
- Round-trip air fare covered by the university

- Indicate the proposed two courses to be taught and include preliminary syllabi
- Note your knowledge of Italy and any speaking ability in Italian

Faculty in the summer program will receive normal summer salary for teaching two courses (6 units).

The Selection Committee will consider the following in seeking the appropriate appointee:

1. Application form, statement of objectives, and proposed courses (2)
2. Knowledge and speaking ability of the language of that particular country, as appropriate.
3. Support of department chair (and Dean, if faculty member not from H&SS).
4. Personal interview, as appropriate.
