Psychology Peer Mentors (PPM) offer mentoring and outreach. We invite undergraduate psychology majors and MA/MS students to join Psychology Peer Mentors. Enthusiasm and a caring attitude required.

Peer Mentor activities include:

- Staffing the Psychology Peer Mentor Office (H515);
- Offering outreach to students at high schools and community colleges;
- Supporting the Psychology Advisement Office;
- Maintaining the Peer Mentor Bulletin Board;
- Publishing the Peer Mentor Newsletter;
- Sponsoring a Psychology Day event or activity.

Psychology 496 Units:

Students electing academic credit complete an “activity plan” with the faculty advisor no later than the third week of classes and keep a portfolio of their activities. Portfolios will be reviewed during Finals Week. Students may enroll in one to three units.

- One Unit: Two to three hours per week; minimum of one office hour and attendance at periodic group meetings.
- Two Units: Four hours per week; minimum of two office hour and attendance at periodic group meetings.
- Three Units: Six hours per week; minimum of three office hour and attendance at periodic group meetings. Students electing three units are required to submit articles for the Newsletter.

Office holder in Department Clubs (PDSA, Psi Chi, and APSSC) are honorary members of PPM and qualify for Psychology 496 credit.

Note. Psychology 496 units do not count toward GE, major, or minor graduation requirements.
