Prof. Sarah Hill, Associate Professor of Political Science, will be leading POSC 315 – Journey in Advocacy in Spring 2020. This course is ideal for students who wish to learn how to be effective advocates for the policy issues that are most important to them.

As part of the course, **students will travel to Sacramento for a FREE 1-2 day trip** – and practice advocacy with California legislators. The trip to Sacramento is covered by university funds, so students are only responsible for regular course semester registration.
