Membership Requirements

Undergraduates:

1. Must be an officially declared Sociology major or minor
2. Must be at least a junior by CSUF standards
3. Must have at least a **3.3 cumulative GPA**
4. Must have at least a 3.0 GPA in Sociology courses taken at CSUF
5. Must have completed at least four regular courses in Sociology prior to initiation (exclusive of extension or courses graded pass/fail)

Graduates:

1. Completion of one semester of CSUF graduate study in Sociology
2. Graduate GPA of 3.0 or higher
3. Continued matriculation in a program of study leading toward a graduate degree in Sociology at CSUF
