- 1. Southern California Conference for Undergraduate Research. Aimed towards providing experience. CSUF is covering the cost for 60 students to go to the event. It will take place at UC Irvine. Abstract admission due Oct. 21st, actual event Nov. 12th.
- E. A.S.I. Liaisons Liz Sanchez and Jesse Rodriguez:
  - 1. Governance Committee: Working on getting language to be more gender inclusive. Also working on changing the language for election bylaws.

(Titan dreamers, Asian Pacific American Resource Center, Women and Adult Reentry center, Queer Resource Center, Chicano/Chicana resource centers.)
