Transfer students *typically* come needing between 3-4 GE courses – 9 units of upper division GE (that can be from any GE area), and occasionally a smaller number of units in B. This schedule builds in room for 4 GE courses. Please note that Sociology classes do not count towards GE requirements. Transfer students typically come with Soc 101 already completed, thus this plan lists only the remaining 4 core courses.

Transfer students typically come with 2 electives already completed. Nevertheless, this plan lists 8 sociology electives, but the final 2 are marked as “if necessary courses”.
